## **POLICY:**

  - (a) achieves appropriate results for the appropriate persons at an appropriate cost as defined by the Workers Compensation Board Ends Policy; and
  - (b) avoids unacceptable actions and situations as defined by the Workers Compensation Board Executive Limitations policies.
