

POLICY NUMBER: POL-97 Chapter: BOARD OF DIRECTORS Subject: EXECUTIVE LIMITATIONS, COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS Effective Date: January 23, 2003 **Last Update:** May 9, 2019 **PURPOSE:** The purpose of this policy is to set out the Chief Executive Officer's responsibilities and limitations with respect to employment, compensation and benefits. **REFERENCE:** Workers Compensation Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. W-7.1, Sections 30, 31 Occupational Health and Safety Act R.S.P.E.I. 1988, Cap. 0-1.01, Section 4 Workers Compensation Board Policy, POL-40, Board - Chief Executive Officer Relationship, Delegation to the Chief Executive Officer Workers Compensation Board Policy, POL-112, Board - Chief Executive Officer Relationship, Monitoring Chief Executive Officer Performance **DEFINITION: POLICY:**

1. With respect to employment, compensation and benefits to employees, consultants, and contract workers, the Chief Executive Officer shall not cause or allow jeopardy to fiscal integrity or public image.

Accordingly, they shall not:

- A. Change their own compensation and benefits.
- B. Establish current compensation and benefits which deviate materially from the geographic or professional market for the skills employed.

Monitoring

2. This policy will be monitored by the Board of Directors annually and reviewed in accordance with the annual monitoring schedule as set out in Workers Compensation Board policy, POL-112, Board - Chief Executive Officer Relationship, Monitoring Chief Executive Officer Performance.
