# OHS Prevention Services Team

- The WCB Prevention Services team consists of a Youth Education Consultant (YEC) and two Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) Education Consultants. While their roles and responsibilities often overlap, our YEC specifically focuses on education initiatives for young workers under the age of 25.
- Our OHS Education Consultants engage with and educate both employers and workers of various industries. All members of the Prevention Services team work towards a common goal of assisting workplaces in eliminating work-related injury and illness.
- OHS Consultants collaborate closely with employers and workers to make sure PEI workplaces comply with legislated safety standards. OHS Consultants provide education services to minimize risks, prevent incidents, and support employers in promoting the overall physical and psychological health and safety of workers.

## Consulting Services:

Our Consultants provide a wide array of services. These include in-person and virtual workshops tailored for both employers and workers, visiting workplaces to guide them through OHS legislation, and leading educational programs for young workers in schools throughout Prince Edward Island.
